**RE: Status of Lake County's request for DNRC Technical Review of Johnson  
Creek 100-Year Floodplain Delineation**

Dear Peter,

This letter is intended to notify the Swan Lakers that Lake County has received an amendment to the 100-Year Floodplain Delineation report for Johnson Creek from Billmayer & Hafferman, Inc. for River Run Associates.

This amendment, dated November 18, 2009, addresses comments and questions raised by DNRC review of the April 6, 2009 floodplain delineation report prepared by Billmayer & Hafferman. The amendment provides supplemental information and incorporates the results of an independent hydrology report prepared by Applied Water Consulting, dated November 2009.

Lake County has requested DNRC technical review of the reports. Larry Schock, DNRC Regional Floodplain Engineer, and Steve Story, DNRC State Floodplain Engineer, have received copies of the reports and will be providing technical review to the county.

When DNRC is finished with the technical review of this new information, and if it is determined that no additional information or changes are necessary, Lake County will provide the Swan Lakers with written notice and will withhold any final determination of the delineation until the "Floodplain Delineation Dispute Resolution Process" is completed as per the settlement agreement.
