Lake County has received a response from the Missoula Regional Office of the Department of Natural Resources and Conservation (DNRC) regarding the technical review of the Floodplain Delineation Report for Johnson Creek at the Historic Kootenai Lodge dated April 6, 2009, and received by Lake County on April 9, 2009. The report was supplemented with the HEC-RAS model and a map of the cross sections that were provided to Lake County on May 26, 2009 and subsequently forwarded to DNRC in order to enable full review of the submitted delineation.

The DNRC has identified specific concerns, questions and recommendations that Lake County feels must be satisfactorily addressed. The DNRC comments are documented in the attached response. Lake County is hereby forwarding this to you so that you can properly address the identified concerns, questions and recommendations through either an amendment to or as a supplement of the submitted floodplain delineation report.

Please continue to send all information directly to Lake County. We will then forward the information directly to DNRC for technical review of the delineation report.

Once Lake County is satisfied with the delineation, based on the comment received from the DNRC technical review, we shall proceed with the "Floodplain Delineation Dispute Resolution Process" as outlined in the "Settlement Stipulation and Release".
